Job Purpose: To provide a parish nursing service that integrates spiritual, physical, psychological, emotional and social health to the local community, regardless of faith or belief.

Vision:

St Paul's Rossmore Road is looking to employ a NMC Registered Nurse in a paid part-time position to lead their new Parish Nursing (Public Health) project. This innovative service is provided in partnership with Parish Nursing Ministries UK with funding support from Westminster City Council, Healthy Communities Fund. The Parish Nurse will work closely with the clergy and pastoral team at St Paul's, including the parish Food & Wellbeing Manager, in their shared aim to improve holistic health and wellbeing with those living in the parish.

The Parish Nurse role includes:

- Providing spiritual care in partnership with clergy and pastoral team
- Offer health education, encouragement, compassion and pastoral support;
- Attending community meal once a month (Wed eve); monthly Coffee Morning (Wed morning); Wellbeing Support Group once a month (Mon); and one Sunday service a month (Sun am).
- Personal (one-to-one) health screening, support, advice, and referral
- Group workshops on health and wellbeing – both leading and facilitating
- Advocating for individuals and health more widely
- Referring people to appropriate health and wellbeing services
- Liaising closely with other local health services, primary care trust, community health workers, social prescribing, counselling and pastoral teams
- Personal (one-to-one) health screening, support, advice, and referral
- Supporting the wider health, safety and risk management of the church and congregation
- Current registration with the Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC) is essential and support for revalidation is provided
- Training provided by Parish Nursing UK is required*

*The appointed candidate will be required to undertake formal role preparation with Parish Nursing Ministries UK and offer spiritual care, including Christian prayer when requested, as part of St Paul's ministry and pastoral team. It is therefore a Genuine Occupational Requirement for the applicant to be a Christian.
